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This Indenture made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of January one thousand Eight hundred and Seven  
between Hugh McVay of the state of South Carolina and Greenville District, of the one part  
and Jeremiah Pace of the other part, of the district and State aforesaid, Witnesseth  
that the said Hugh McVay for the consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars  
to him in hand paid by the said Jeremiah Pace the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
and I the said Hugh McVay Have granted bargained and sold unto the said Jeremiah  
Pace a certain tract or parcel of land containing Sixty acres more or less lying on  
South side of South Tygar River, in the State and district aforesaid it being part  
of a tract of two hundred acres granted to Tobias Putt, by His Excellency  
Benjamin Gurrard Esq<sup>r</sup> bearing date the twenty first day of January one thousand  
Seven hundred and Eighty five, and recorded in the Secretary's office in grant book  
cccc page 355, Beginning at the said River where the said Putts line crosses the  
River, thence along the said line with Duncan Wilkersons to a black oak thence along  
the said line with Abraham Chastain's land to a red oak, thence along the old line  
to the said river thence down the said river to the Beginning as it meanders —  
also a part of another tract of land lying and joining on the West side of the  
above mentioned tract of land containing Ninety four acres, it being part of  
a tract of Four hundred and ninety acres granted to John Portman by his Excellency  
William Moultrie bearing date the fifth day of June one thousand Seven  
hundred and Eighty six, & Recorded in grant book III, page 532, Beginning at the said  
River running along the said line with Putts land to a red oak thence along Chastain's  
land to a white oak thence along Arthur Barretts line to a stake, thence along  
the said line to Henry Prince line thence along said line to the river thence down the  
river as it meanders to the Beginning. Together with all the houseaments and  
appurtenances to the said premises, To have and To Hold all and singular the  
premises above mentioned unto the said Jeremiah Pace his heirs and assigns  
forever and I the said Hugh McVay do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors  
Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
the said Jeremiah Pace his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every person  
or persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In Witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and date above mentioned —
