


The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I David

 dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Arnold of State and District aforesaid Have
 granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and Release unto the said Benjamin Arnold all that plantation or tract of land containing
 thirty three acres be the same more or less Situate in the District of Greenville lying on
 Horse Creek waters of Needy River, Beginning on a sweet gum st on Horse Creek Planting,
 thence S 60. W. 67.5 bounding on Wm Franum to a dogwood st thence N 30. W. 26.50 bounding on
 the said Benj^r Arnold to a dogwood st thence N 60. E. 16.75 bounding on David Franum
 to a sweet gum st on horse creek thence down the meanders of said Creek to the beginning
 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the said Benj^r Arnold to him his heirs & assigns
 forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Benj^r Arnold
 to him his heirs and assigns against me myself and my heirs and against every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof
 Witness my hand and seal this thirtieth day of March. In the year of our Lord one thousand
