State of South Carolina Spartanburgh District, Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Roddy of Greenville District and State aforesaid, have this day bargained sold and delivered unto John Gowen of Spartanburgh the following property viz: A grey house and one sorrel filly, two cows of calves & four hogs together with all my household furniture. Conditions of the above obligation is such that if the above mentioned Thomas Roddy do pay unto the above John Gowen in twelve months from the date hereof two hundred bushels of good sound corn & seven bushels and one half peck more for the plantation he lives on. Peach orchard excepted the said Thomas Roddy is to receive a mill belonging to John Gowen which he is to have in his possession (twelve months) in as good order as she now is excepting the natural wear. S. Gowen is to pay for turning the tunnel head thru the above bill sale to be void otherwise to remain in force & to stand - Given under my hand the 6th day of March 1809. Executed in the presence of
