Witnesseth that the said Elisha Stephens for and in consideration of the sum of seventy nine Dollars & seventy five Cents Have mortgage unto the said Beverly Borroum his heirs or assigns the following property (Viz) one bay horse blind in both eyes also two feather beds and furniture also twenty eight head of hogs marked thus a cross and two slits in the left ear and a hole in the right ear, also two pots two pair Chain traces with hames, two ploughs & four weeding hoes, also one set of Coopers tools &c. Which said property the said Stephens mortgage unto the said Borroum in virtue of having had and received of the said Borroum the said sum of seventy nine dollars & 75 c<sup>ts</sup> the said Stephens having the Equity of Redemption that is to say paying and discharging the said sum of seventy nine dollars & 75 c<sup>ts</sup> unto the said Borroum on or before the 25<sup>th</sup> of December next then this instrument and agreement to be void otherwise the forfeiture of this mortgage to be carried into effect.
