singular the rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Premises belong  
or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the  
premises before mentioned unto the said William Edwards by heirs and assigns  
forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators & assigns  
to warrant and favour defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said  
William Edwards his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against any  
other Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
