The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents, that I James Kilgore of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of fourteen pounds Sterling in hand paid by John Kitchens of the State and County aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Kitchens all that tract or parcel of Land, containing one hundred acres be the same more or less, it being a part of a tract of 400 acres on the south side of Broad River, in Greenville County, surveyed the fifth day of January one thousand seven hundred and seventy five, on a warrant dated the Eighth day of December one thousand seven hundred and eighty four, and granted to Daniel Heizer on the fiftenth day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty four, the land to be conveyed. Begins on the south side of Rocky creek, where the old indian line crosses said creek, thence due south on said
