Gilbert for & in consideration of Two hundred dollars Specie Current money of said State to me in hand paid by Reubin Smith, Have granted bargained sold and Released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Reubin Smith all that tract of land, lying in said District on both sides of Brushy Creek waters of Enace River containing one hundred and sixty nine acres, Cornering on a Post oak 34 the north side of said Creek running thence South 30 N 35 Chains to a Black Jack 34 thence S 60 East 38 Chains 72 links to a post oak thence N 30 N 40 Chains 50 links crossing said Creek to a post oak thence N 35 N 39
