This Indenture made & confirmed this thirteenth day of January in the year of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & six between William Simsly of the one part, & John Battson of the other both of the State of South Carolina and the district of Greenville, as Witnesses for and in consideration of the sum one hundred pounds to him paid in hand by the said John Battson, Have granted & bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Battson two hundred acres of land, out of a large tract of 400 acres Being & lying in Greenville district on Reedy River originally granted unto Joseph Boy bearing date 1785. Beginning at a post oak corner, running thence S. 60. E. W. 43. chains 95. links to a stake thence S. 25. E. 45. Chs. and 50 links crossing the River to a stake thence to the Beginning containing two hundred acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Battson his heirs & assigns forever, I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c. to warrant and forever defend all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John Battson his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs & against every other Person claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
