This Indenture made this 18th day of May one thousand Eight hundred and one between Jeremiah Pace of the State of South Carolina Greenville district of the one part and Hugh McWay of the other of the State and district aforesaid Witnesseth that the said Jeremiah Pace for the consideration of four hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by the said Hugh McWay the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, & the said Jeremiah Pace have granted bargained & sold unto the said Hugh McWay a certain tract or parcel of Land containing Sixty acres more or less lying on the south side of South Tyger River in the State & district aforesaid being a part of Two hundred acres granted to Tobias Puttall by his Excellency Benjamin Guirard Esq. bearing date the twenty fifth day of January one thousand seven hundred and eighty five Recorded in secretaries office in grant Book 63 36 Page 355. beginning at the said river where the said Puttall line crosses the river then along said line with Duncan Wilkinson to a black oak
