

State of South Carolina; Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Underwood of Greenville District in the State aforesaid Labourer in Consideration of four hundred & eighty Dollars to me paid by Stephen Holtzclaw of Greenville District in the State aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Stephen Holtzclaw all that plantation or tract of Land containing Two hundred and forty acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in Greenville District in the State aforesaid on Princes Creek waters of Enoree River the same being part of two tracts of Land originally granted to Joseph McLaughlin bearing date the twenty first day of January A.D. 1785. and the first day of January A.D. 1787. Difference thereunto being has will more fully appear Beginning on a red oak corner $\frac{3}{4}$ on the north of a branch of the aforesaid Creek thence S. 62. E. to a Willow corner $\frac{3}{4}$ in the fork of said Branch thence up the south prong curving the meanders to a ash corner $\frac{3}{4}$ on the aforesaid prong thence N. 6. E. 1 chⁿ 36 links to a red oak corner $\frac{3}{4}$ old mark thence S. 60. E. 60 chⁿ to a red oak mark $\frac{3}{4}$ thence S. 20. W. 20 chain to a Black Jack marked $\frac{3}{4}$ thence S. 80. W. 25 chⁿ 50 links to a red oak $\frac{3}{4}$ thence N. 40. W. 27 chⁿ 50 links to a post oak $\frac{3}{4}$ thence S. 50. W. 35 chⁿ to the creek thence up the meanders of the said Creek to the upper line of the first survey thence N. 30. E. 3 chⁿ to a black oak $\frac{3}{4}$ thence a straight line to a black the Beginning Red oak corner near the branch Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Stephen Holtzclaw his heirs & assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to answer and forever defend all and singular the s^d premises unto the said Stephen Holtzclaw his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
