South Carolina Greenville County; Know all men by these presents that I Jesse Dunkin of the State County aforesaid planter, am held & firmly bound to David Garrison of the same place, in the penal sum of four hundred pound Sterling which payment well and truly be made and done I do bind myself and each and every of my heirs Executors & administrators firmly by these presents sealed with my seal and dated this 11th day of January A.D. 1793. The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Jesse Dunkin his heirs &c as the case may be do make a good and sufficient Right & title generally warranted to a certain tract of Land situate in Greenville County on Saluda River containing two hundred and sixty five acres more or less being the plantation on which the said Jesse Dunkin now lives on or before the first day of November next ensuing the date hereof, to and for the aforesaid David Garrison without fraud or further delay then the above obligation to be void and else to remain in full force and virtue in Law; Signed Sealed & Delivered in the presence of us. R. Maxwell, John Ware, Jesse Dunkin
