Rice of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of
one thousand Dollars to him in hand paid by Eli Baldwin of the same district and State
aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents Do grant bargain
& sell and Release unto the said Eli Baldwin a plantation or tract of Land lying & being on
the waters of the grove creek, being part of a tract of Land granted to James Seaborn and
signed by his Excellency Benjamin Guirard on the fifteenth day of October One thousand
seven hundred and eighty four and also part of a tract of land originally granted to
S^r Moody and S^r Sagar to his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the fourth day of June 1787
containing by Estimation One hundred and seventy acres Be the same more or less
laid out as follows Beginning at a Red oak on James Seaborn near the old Trade Road
thence N. 28 Ets to a broken top red oak on W^{est} side thence N 75 W 23 Ets to a Hickory
on Lashby Tarrast land thence on said Tarrast S 21 W 22 Ets to a Branch on a branch
of the Golden from thence up said branch to the middle prong of it thence
up the middle prong to a large poplar on the head of said prong near
Moody's old field thence East to a Stake on the side Seaborn thence north to the
Beginning corner, Together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments, &
appurtenances to the premises before mentioned unto the said Eli Baldwin his heirs Executors
administrators or assigns, and I hereby bind myself my heirs or assigns to warrant and
forever defend all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Eli Baldwin
his heirs or assigns against myself my heirs and against every other Person or Person
