Gullers Creek Except so much as has been heretofore conveyed by William Mitchupson to said William Bryant bounding on John Dacus Land, be the same more or less Together with all and singular the Rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident thereto. To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Bryant his heirs Executors administrators or assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c. to warrant and forever defend all & singular the above described premises unto the only use and behoof of him the said William Bryant his heirs and assigns forever, against myself my heirs and against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand & seal this twenty third day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & three & in the twenty seventh year of the independence of the United States of America — John Mitchupson Seal
