Have granted bargained sold and Released unto the said John Chandler by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release a plantation or parcel of Land on Wolfe Creek and Waters of Beaver dam Creek, branches of Enace River, in the dist. of Greenville aforesaid. Beginning at a Lightwood Stake my corner and Running thence S. 75 W. 70 Ch<sup>rs</sup> to a stake, thence N. 4 W. 78 Ch<sup>rs</sup> to a hickory on Clayton Fords line, thence S. 10 Ch<sup>rs</sup> to a stake on Woods line, thence S. 27 E. 60 Chain with s<sup>d</sup> line to a Stake, thence N. 63 E. 15 Chain to a Stake, thence S. 41 E. to the Beginning, Containing by estimation Two hundred and fifty acres, the same being part and the East end of a tract of Land granted to Samuel Warren by Patent bearing date 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 1786 and by him conveyed to me by deed of Conveyance bearing date December 1<sup>st</sup> 1799 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances
