State South Carolina; Know all men by these presents that I John Gorren of Spartanburgh District, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by John Chandler late of Greenville District. Have granted bargained sold and released unto the said John Chandler by these presents to grant bargain sell and Release a plantation or parcel of Land on Wolfe Creek and Waters of Beaver Creek, branch of Enoree River, in the dist. of Greenville afores^t. Beginning at a lightwood Stake my corner and running thence S^o 75 W^o 70 ch^r to a stake, thence N^o 4 W^o 78 ch^r to a Hickory on Clayton Post line, thence E^o 10 ch^r to a Stake on Woods line, thence S^o 27 E^o 00 chain with s^o line to a Stake, thence N^o 63 E^o 13 chain to a Stake, thence S^o 41 E^o to the Beginning, containing by estimation two hundred and fifty acres, the same being part and the East end of a tract of Land granted to Samuel Marca by Patent bearing date 6th day of November 1786 and by him conveyed to me by deed of Conveyance bearing date December 1st 1799 together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances
