This Indenture made the 18<sup>th</sup> of June AD. 1800 between John Miller of the District  
of Greenville of the one part. William Griffin of the other. Witnesseth that the  
said Miller for the sum of Two hundred dollars in hand paid by <sup>sa</sup> Griffin  
the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, and hath by these presents  
granted and sold & doth by these presents deliver & confirm unto the said William  
Griffin his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying  
and bounding (as follows) on waters of the Enoree containing one hundred acres be the  
more or less. Beginning on a pine on Kelleys line thence along said line to a pine  
stake corner thence on s<sup>d</sup> line to a red oak thence to a post oak stake corner  
thence on his line to a Chestnut corner, thence a new line to a black jack  
corner, thence a new line to the Beginning. With all houses orchards gardens  
fences woods, underwoods, water & water courses thereunto belonging or any wise  
belonging or appertaining thereto, To have and To hold the said tract or parcel of  
Land, and all the before mentioned premises unto the said William Griffin and his heirs  
forever, to warrant and defend the said tract of Land & premises unto the said William  
Griffin his heirs & assigns forever. In Witness whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Miller hath set his hand
