Know all men by these presents that Jeremiah Tull of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four Hundred dollars to him in hand paid the Receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged. Have bargained sold and by these presents do bargain sell & deliver to young Griffin, of the State and district aforesaid, all that parcel or tract of land containing four hundred and twenty three acres be the same more or less situate in the State and district aforesaid on Enoree River, being a part of two tracts of land one tract granted to John Turnbough dated June 15th day 1786. the other part granted to Robert Prince the 17th day of March 1787. it being part of a tract of land containing four thousand acres bounded as follows Beginning at a maple on the long branch, thence across the River to a pine corner, thence to a red oak thence across branch to a stake a conditional corner made between Jeremiah Tull and Laird and thence on a conditional line to a Red oak corner thence with said line to a take, thence to a post oak Pine corner thence across the River to a stake a conditional corner made between Jeremiah Tull & Thomas Swafford thence along a condition line, to a Hickory, thence along the said line to a red oak thence to continue the course to a stake on the taken line, thence along the said line to a stake corner to a post oak corner, thence along the said line to a pine, Savage's corner thence Red oak from thence to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, To have & to hold the said tract of land aforesaid mentioned, against any claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever claiming the same or any part thereof, against myself my heirs Executon & Repg
