

presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Eli Baldwin a certain
tract of land lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the South West
side of Peedy River, containing one hundred and fifteen acres originally granted
to Andrew Thomson & assigned by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq. on the second
day of February One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine, Beginning
on a pine on the River West to a post oak 30 Chains North 75 West 25 Chains to a black oak
corner South 15 W. 30 Chains to a pine corner, North 15 East 37 Chains to an oak corner
corner, on ^{the} River then up ^{the} River to the Beginning, reference to a plat will more
fully appear, Together with all the appurtenances, To Have & To Hold all and singular
the premises to the said Eli Baldwin, his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my-
self my heirs Executor & administrator to warrant and forever defend the above sold Land
