us in hand paid by William Johnson of Greenville district aforesaid, Do grant bargain sell  
Release unto the said William Johnson his heirs & assigns forever, all that tract or  
parcel of land, containing thirty five acres, Situate in Greenville district in the State  
afores<sup>d</sup> it being one half of seventy acres formerly the property of Mary Austin Deceased,  
to be Equally divided between the said Drury Austin and Mary Austin his sister;  
by a line running <sup>Eastwardly</sup> Westwardly and the land to be conveyed is the Southwardly part of said  
twenty acres, Together with all and singular the Rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances  
unto said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereunto, And we  
do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend the  
above described premises unto the said William Johnson his heirs Executors & administrators and  
assigns forever against our heirs Executors & Administrators and against every other Person whomsoever  
lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof; Witness our hands & seals this 7<sup>th</sup> of March  
1809. & in the thirty third year of the independency of the United States of America
