 Samuel Neily of s^t. S. Carolina & Greenville district at & before the sealing
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 by said James Langston and he being fully satisfied therewith have
 bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain
 sell and convey unto the s^t. Samuel Neily a certain plantation
 or tract of Land lying & being on a branch of Reed's River containing fifty
 acres more or less, Beginning at a Simon corner running on Solomon Langston
 s^t. land to a pine corner thence running adjoining the said Langston's Land
 to Cherry nut corner thence on s^t. Langston's line to a post oak thence along
 said Langston's line to a post stake corner thence along a conditional
 line to the Beginning corner having such shape form marks buttings and
 bounding as the above plat of one hundred and ten acres represents —
 Together with all good singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 To have and To hold the above said tract of Land of fifty more or less
 unto the said Samuel Neily his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend the said
 land and premises unto the s^t. Samuel Neily his heirs and assigns forever
 and also from the lawfull claims or demands of any person lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof — In Witness whereof
