

Know all men by these presents that I Solomon Langston of District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of forty Dollars to me paid by Samuel Neily of Greenville district State aforesaid, Have bargained sold and released, and by these presents Do bargain sell and release unto the said Samuel Neily a parcel or tract of Land supposed to be fifty acres, situate lying and being in Greenville District being a part of a tract of Land originally granted to John Langston Senior in the year 1784: the said parcel Beginning at a post oak at Andrew Bridges barn thence a straight line the course of the path from the aforesaid post oak until it strikes the original line thence along the original line S 68. E. to a pine corner thence along the original line S 22. W. to a post oak corner of the said Samuel Neily's land along the said Neily's line to a State corner thence along Andrew Bridges line to the Beginning, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the thence belonging, To Have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Neily his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Samuel Neily his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons claiming the same or any part thereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & nine signed sealed & Delivered in the presence of
