The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Berry Holland of Greenville district and State aforesaid in consideration of fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Hill of the State and district aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto the said Henry Hill all that plantation or tract of Land containing forty seven acres be the same more or less, Situate in Greenville district lying on the branches of Horse Creek waters of Reddy River Beginning on an ash 3+ on a branch running thence S. 40 E. 36. 00 to a red oak 3+ bounding on the said Henry Hill's land thence S. 47 N. 21. 50 to a pine 3+ on the old Indian boundary line thence N. 42 W. 19. 50 to a hickory 3+ bounding on the aforesaid Berry Holland's land thence N. 50 E. 12. 00 to a maple 3+ on a branch thence across the meander of said branch to the Beginning, Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have & to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Henry Hill his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant & defend defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry Hill his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to Claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this twenty fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and ten & in the thirty fourth year of the Independence of the United States of America -
