Know all men by these presents that I Aquilla Brasher of the State of Kentucky for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars paid by Thomas Jones of state & District aforesaid. Have granted sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Thomas Jones one hundred and thirty Eight acres of Land lying in Greenville District on a branch of the Reedy fork of Reedy River being part of a tract of Land granted to Coswaldier Sony assigned by his excellency Tho^s Pinckney on the thirtieth day of December 1787. & also part of a tract of Land granted to Rob^t Gilliam & assigned by his excellency Thomas Pinckney on the seventh day of April 1788. the s^d one hundred thirty Eight acres of Land more or less laid out to the s^d Tho^s Jones as follows. Beginning at a pine corner on said Brasher line running N 55. W. 9 to a hickory, thence N 33 E. 15. 25 to a Post oak, thence N. 38 W. 55 to a stake on Edmond Sanders line, thence N. 28 E. 9. 50 to a post oak on s^d Sanders line, thence S. 62 E. 58 on s^d Sanders line to a Post oak on Mt Washers thence S. 6 E. 12 to a Poplar s^d Brasher & from thence to the Beginning - Including one hundred and thirty Eight acres more or less, Together with all that appertains to s^d Land & premises or any wise incident To have & To hold to the said Thomas Jones his heirs & assigns forever. I the s^d Aquilla Brasher doth hereby warrant and forever defend the afores^d Land & premises to the said Thomas Jones his heirs & assigns forever, from myself my heirs and assigns & from all other Persons claiming the same or any part thereof.
