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The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Jonathan Ward of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Silas Holloway of the state and district aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold & Released and by these presents Do grant, bargain sell and Release unto the said Silas Holloway one certain tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred acres more or less situate in the district of Greenville on the water of the Golden Grove Creek being part of a tract of Land originally granted to William Armstrong by grant bearing date the fifteenth of October 1784. and by him conveyed to the said Jonathan Ward by deed bearing date the Eighth day of June 1795. and Recorded in the Clerk's office in Book D. page 144. the 11th day of August 1795. Beginning on a Red oak corner on Judge Pendleton's line near the branch thence by a line of marked trees agreed on by the parties to the mouth of Harry Paris's spring branch thence up the meanders of the main branch to William Brashers line, thence N. 45 E. 40 chains along William Brashers line, to a corner agreed on by the parties, thence S. 45 E. 40 chains with a line of marked trees to the head of the Indigo dam branch thence down the side and of the said branch to an ash corner on the original line, thence S. 45 W. with the said line to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises to the said Premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Silas Holloway his heirs and assigns, forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Silas Holloway his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other Persons or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof —
