 full age date d July 15<sup>th</sup> 1811 he s<sup>r</sup> Brooks having Rec<sup>d</sup> all moneys due to him  
 from s<sup>r</sup> Glenn as his Guardian and given Acquittance of all claims or demands w<sup>ch</sup>  
 in law or equity I do hereby on my part requit all my rights and claims from me  
 my Heirs Executors Adm<sup>r</sup>s or Assigns of the within mentioned mortgage to him the  
 W<sup>o</sup> Blagrove Glenn his Heirs Executors Adm<sup>r</sup>s and Assigns forever given under my  
 hand and seal this tenth day of Aug<sup>o</sup> 1811
