Rofs of the distrid of aforesaid HOWE granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Rice F. Rofs a tract or parcel of land lasting and being in the distrid of aforesaid on the N. side of S. Pacolet River Beginning at an ash on the south side of the River a south course from the mouth of the branch that S. Easley still house is on thence up the several meanders of the River to the ford called the waggon ford near William Camrons house thence south 41 N. 5 Chain to a white oak stump near the ridge road thence S. 86. N. 11 Chain to a hickory thence N. 2 N. 7 Chain 50 lks to a black oak thence N. 5 N. 9 Chain to a stake near the Jugaloo road thence S. 4 Ch. 50 links to a Blk oak Bates corner thence N. 5 Ch. with his line to a black oak thence N. 31 Ch. 50 Lks to some black oak saplings on Moses Whites line thence N. 72 E. with his line 5 Ch. to a maple on the creek thence up the meanders of the creek to a white oak thence N. 70 E. 10 Ch. to a post oak thence N. 15 N. 7 Ch. 50 links to a post oak thence E. 19 Ch. 50 lks to an ash on the still house branch thence down the meanders of the branch to the Beginning, Containing one hundred acres be the same more or less the same being part of two tracts of land granted to John Gowen the principal & greater part of which is out of one bearing date 21st Jan^y 1785. whereon I the said Easley lived also one other tract or parcel of land joining the above & beginning at the above mentioned saplings and running a west course with Moses Whites line to his corner thence with Willey S.
