State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I John Hall of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid, Taylor for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Dollars to me in hand paid by Raphael Johnson of the same place Sumner Have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents DO grant bargain sell and release unto the said Raphael Johnson his heirs and assigns forever one house outhouses and two Lots of land in the village of Pleasantburg at Greenville Courthouse known and distinguished in the Plan or Chart of said Village by the numbers forty & forty one (40 & 41) Beginning on a stake corner at the corner of the street opposite Cleveland's store house running thence S. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 235 feet to a stake, thence N. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 140 feet to a stake, thence N. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 235 feet to a stake, thence S. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 140 feet to a stake the Beginning. Containing about one acre, being the same which I purchased at Sheriff's sale of John Wood Esquire having been sold as the property of Jason Plant to satisfy an execution in behalf of Aba Bunnell, and conveyed to the said Jason Plant by Samuel S.
