14 ch. 50 lks to a white oak thence S. 60 E. 15 ch 50 lks to a red oak sapling thence  
N. 77 W. 11 ch. to a stone thence S. 42. W. 17 ch. 50 lks to a hickory on the river thence  
up the meander of the said river to the Beginning; to include Twenty acre  
Together with all and singular the rights hereditaments members and  
appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
to the said Premises. To have & To hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said William Paden his heirs and assigns for ever.  
And I William Arnold Do hereby bind myself my heirs and administrators  
and assigns to warrant and forever defend the above Premises unto the said  
William Paden his heirs administrators and assigns against myself and my  
heirs, and against every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
