State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Hans Black  
of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of  
four hundred Dollars to me paid by Henry Brasher of the district and State  
aforesaid, Have granted bargained and released and by these presents Do  
grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry Brasher one hundred &  
thirty acres of Land more or less lying in Greenville District on the Reedy  
Fork of Reedy Run being part of a tract of Land originally granted to  
Keumar Hudson and signed by his Excellency Benjamin Guiscard on the  
fifteenth day of October one thousand seven hundred and Eighty four, and  
also part of a tract originally granted to Hans Black and signed by his  
Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the first day of October one thousand seven  
hundred Eighty seven the said one hundred and thirty acres more or less is  
laid out unto the said Henry Brasher as follows, Beginning on the south side of  
Reedy Fork on a black oak the original corner on Crofts land and running  
Westward to a pine corner thence running northward to a black oak a conditional  
corner between Croft and the said land thence running on a conditional line between  
Croft and the said Black to a black-jack corner on the original line, thence running  
along the original line South East to a stake corner on James Samford's land thence N. 40  
W. to a pine by chains thence N. 50 E. to a conditional pine corner on William Cox  
land, thence running on a conditional line between William Cox and said land to a sand  
quod corner on the Reedy fork thence running up and binding on the said Reedy fork  
to the Beginning, including one hundred and thirty acres of land more or less —  
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
Henry Brasher his heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs  
Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
one hundred and thirty acres of land more or less with the premises unto the said  
Henry Brasher his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and all &  
every other Person or Persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof I subscribe unto set my hand &  
seal this seventeenth day of November one thousand Eight hundred & one. Signed, sealed and  
Delivered in presence of us
