


that I Ealy Meritt the wife of Benjamin Meritt Doest doo Relinquish all  
her right title and claim of the Estate of Benjamin Doest, unto John  
Hodges his heirs and assigns, and doo warrant and forever defend the  
claim to be just — Given under my hand and seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of  
September 1812. Ealy  Meritt 

To John Phillips, Stephen Phillips —

S. Carolina G. District. Personally came Stephen Phillips, before me the subscriber,  
Juster and being duly sworn maketh oath that he was present and did see  
Ealy Meritt sign seal and as her act and deed deliver the within deed  
of conveyance for the uses and purposes within mentioned, and that John Phillips,  
together with himself were in the presence subscribing witness, to the same

The state of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents, that I John  
Anderson of the State aforesaid and district of Greenville for the sum of one  
hundred Dollars paid by Luke Ray of the said State and district, Have  
granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain  
sell and release to the said Luke Ray his heirs and assigns, all that tract or  
parcel of land in the district and state above mentioned, on Horse creek of  
Reedy River Beginning on the said horse creek on a gum bush & near a spring  
thence up the said creek with its meanders to a maple & being about 24 chain  
thence S.W. 50° 21 chain, to a chestnut bush on flatiron Sullivan line thence  
S.E. 25° 24 ch. to a Red oak & 3W Hudson Berry line, thence N.E. 50° 21 chain  
to the Beginning. supposed to contain fifty acres be the same more or less. —  
To Have & to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
said Ray forever, Together with the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances  
to them belonging or in any wise incident or pertaining. And I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs executors &c to warrant and forever defend the said
