Know all men by these presents that I Robert Breswell of Laurens, district State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Ferry of the district & State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold & released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Ferry all that plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred and twenty acres, more or less, situated lying and being in the district of Greenville on the branches of Cedy river bounded on the North by Alexander Caden Land on the East by land formerly belonging to Andrew Wright, on the South by M. Chavis, and on the West by Thomas Hopkins, which said tract of Land was conveyed to the said Robert Breswell by H. T. Walker Sheriff of Greenville district on the Eighth day of May Eighteen hundred and nine, Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Ferry his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Ferry his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal
