John Terry Jun. came personal before me and made oath in due form of Law and sayeth that he was present and did see Robert Breswell sign and as his act and deed deliver the within deed of Conveyance to John Terry Jun. for the use & purposes therein mentioned and that he saw James Saxon with himself subscribe their names as witnesses with himself to the same, sworn to and subscribed the date and date above written before me Hudson Berry J.D. State of South Carolina Greenville District. Know all men by these presents that I William Kelly of the State of Tennessee for in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and forty dollars to me in hand paid by Micajah Berry of the said State and district, I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Micajah Berry a parcel of land containing three hundred and twenty acres it being part of a tract originally granted to John Meun for six hundred and forty acres bearing date sixteenth day of July 1784. and recorded in grant book A. S. A. S. Page 57. lying on Reedy River in the district aforesaid, thence conveyed round to the said William Kelly, Beginning on a sweet gum on said River and running S. 74 N. 39 E. to a white oak on a branch thence up the meanders of said branch about 25 chains to a dead poplar thence on the original line N. 77 chains 40 L. to a post oak thence E. 25 chains to a dead oak on the River thence down the meanders of said River to the Beginning, to include three hundred and twenty acres with the plantation where Bridget Kelly now lives Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident, appertaining, To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Micajah Berry his heirs and assigns forever, And I William Kelly do hereby bind myself, my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and
