To have & to hold all and singular the premises here mentioned unto the said A. Waddill his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors, to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said A. Waddill his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal this twenty sixth day of May in the year of our Lord 1813.
