 and State aforesaid HAVE given granted bargained sold and delivered, & by these Presents do
 give grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Adeline W. Blackley one Negro woman
 named Piddy, about fifteen years of age, one Negro girl named Abby about twelve years old
 also two bay horses, all my stock of Cattle, Hogs and sheep, also all my House hold and
 Kitchen furniture, which said property I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
 Administrators to Warrant and fore or defend unto the said Adeline W. Blackley her
 heirs and assigns for ever, against myself my heirs or assigns, and against every other Person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my
 hand and seal this 16th day of September one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, and in the
 twenty eighth year of the American Independence - Wm Blackley
