



To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry Middleton his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Samuel James Atston doth hereby bind himself, his executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend the same, unto the said Henry Middleton his heirs and assigns against himself, and his heirs, and against every other person, whomsoever laying claim thereto. The State of South Carolina, I know all men by these Presents that I Elias Earle of Pendleton District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Three thousand six hundred and forty dollars to me paid by Henry Middleton of Charleston, in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry Middleton, all those several Plantations or tracts of land, as follow: viz: A tract of 200 acres granted to James Richey 1785; a tract of 285 acres granted to James Richey 21st Sept. 1785. (excepting six acres thereof sold to D. Goodlett) Also 6 acres of land purchased of the said Goodlett; Also 19 acres granted to Job Colcock 3rd April 1786; [Also part of a tract granted to John Timmons 15th Oct. 1784, containing by survey 149 acres, as conveyed by Nat. Stokes to said Earle.] The whole containing Seven hundred and thirteen acres, more or less, and having such form and marks as represented in the Plat hereunto annexed, and being in the district of Greenville, and lying on branches of Richland Creek, waters of Reedy River - Together with all and singular the rights, members, appurtenances and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging; or in any
