Bargain sell & release unto the said Henry Braffier a tract of Land containing  
Four Hundred acres more or less lying in Greenville District on Rock Creek a  
branch of Reedy River being the plantation & tract of Land wherein the sae  
Lewis Weller now lives on & one hundred originally granted to James McDaniel  
and sign by his excellency William Moultrie on the third day of April  
one thousand seven hundred Eighty Six also a tract of Land <sup>containing</sup> one hundred &  
Twenty five acres originally granted to the sae Lewis Weller and sign  
by his Excellency Charles Pinckney on the sixth day of August one thousand  
seven hundred & Ninety two. Also Part of a tract <sup>containing</sup> of Land originally  
granted to said Lewis Weller & signed by his Excellency William Moultrie  
on the third day of February one thousand seven hundred & ninety four  
wherefore being due to the original grants will more fully appear the said  
Four Hundred acres of Land more or less is laid out as follows unto the said  
Henry Braffier. Beginning at a post oak corner, thence running S.E. 50.10  
to a red oak Stevensons corner, thence S.E. 5.10. to a stone corner Morris  
corner thence N.E. 85.35.50. to a red oak Nelsons corner thence  
N.E. 60.28.57. to red oak, thence to a Spanish oak corner, thence N.W. 75.  
to a stake conditional corner between Thomas Long & the said land, thence  
running along a conditional line agreed on by the sae Lewis Weller & Thomas  
Long to a red oak corner on the original line thence S.E. 30. to a pine
