Whereas Mary Somerville by her deed of conveyance bearing date the Eighteenth day of January 1813. did convey to Waddy Thompson a certain tract of Land situate lying & being in the district & state aforesaid containing two hundred & fifty <sup>more or less</sup> bounded by lands originally granted to James Blasingame & Nathaniel Pondleton, & by lands now in the possession of Josiah Thompson & John Jones and whereas the said Mary Somerville & Waddy Thompson have mutually consented to rescind the aforesaid <sup>bargain</sup> & Sale. Now know all men by these presents that I the said Waddy Thompson do hereby recour to the said Mary Somerville, all the rights title & interest of in & unto the said tract or <sup>parcel</sup> of land which she convey to me, in as full & ample a manner as if the said tract or parcel of Land had never been convey to me. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 1814.
