Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Christopher Jackson of Greenville District & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars paid by Thomas Morrow of State aforesaid have granted & doth by these presents sell & release to said Thomas Morrow one Hundred acres of Land more or less lying in Greenville District on the North side of Reedy River being part of a tract of Land of Five Hundred and forty acres originally granted to Lewis Duvall by his excellency William Moultrie on the 31st day of May 1786 as by the original patent and grant will appear the part to be conveyed laid out as follows Beginning on a forked Blackoak on the North bank of Reedy River at Duvalls ford running thence up said River bounded by the water to a gum corner thence N. 86° chains to a pine thence westward to said River thence up the same with the water to Saml Pyles line thence Eastward 52. 22. on said line to a red oak corner on said line thence S. 52° E to a pine corner thence westward on a conditional line between John Brasher & James Hudson to the beginning including by estimation one Hundred acres more or less. Together with all that appertain to said land & premises before mentioned to the said Thomas Morrow his heirs and assigns forever and Lastly I the Christopher Jackson do bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant & forever defend the above described land and
