286 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I William Love and Rachel his wife of Smith County in the State of Tennessee in consideration of Sixty Dollars paid by Silas Bruce of the State and District have Granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Silas Bruce all that Tract or parcel of Land containing Two Hundred and thirteen Acres more or less being my forth & full share of a tract of a Thousand and Twelve acres Granted to Josiah Culbertson, Joseph McCool W^m. D Thomas and W^m. Love situated in Greenville District aforesaid on both sides of Elisha Thompsons Beaver dam out of Middle Tyger River and branches of South fork of said river lying in the middle part of said Tract and Joining Joseph McCools share which lies to the north Josiah Culbertsons share on the south, Bounded on the East by Staffords Land west by Sloans Land Beginning at W^m. Galt Cr. to Robert Forgersons & along said line West 40 chains to a post oak corner North Forgerson line 20 ch. to a pine not corner to Hardin Bruce W^m. 111 chains to an oak over a branch, Cr. on Sloans. South to where a direct line was made and corner marked dividing the whole tract into equal two divisions, East along said partition line to a pine not corner, and thence North 15 ch. or thereabout the W^m. corner to R. Forgersons and being to this work together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said bargain premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Silas Bruce his heirs & assigns forever and I do bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Silas Bruce his heirs against myself my heirs & assigns and Joseph McCool & his heirs for Beaver. March the 9th 1814. William Love (Seal) Rachel Love (Seal) Samuel Rupsel John Brasel Charles Bruce
