on supposed to be sixty acres <sup>in the same</sup> more or less (it being two parts of a tract of land  
out of Five parts) lying adjoining <sup>to</sup> said Hunter Sullivant on Reedy River,  
in Greenville District. Together with all & singular the rights & members  
and hereditaments & appurtenances unto the said premises - To have  
and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
Hunter Sullivant his heirs & assigns forever. And And I do hereby bind  
myself & my heirs forever unto said Hunter Sullivant and his heirs  
forever to warrant & defend the same from me and my heirs &
