 E. 49. to a stake, thence N. 75 W. 40 ch. to a red oak, thence 4 ch. to a  
 stump in the road thence S 43. E 15. ch. to the begining including  
 one hundred & thirty six acres of land, be the same more or less  
 it being part of a tract of Land Granted to J<sup>r</sup>. Lafferty, Together with all  
 that appurtains thereunto To have and to hold, all and singular  
 the Premises to the said Harman Hix his heirs and assigns forever -  
 And I the said Robbins do bind myself my heirs & assigns & administra-  
 tors to warrant and forever defend the above bound Land and pre-  
 mises unto the said Harman Hix his heirs and assigns against my  
 self my heirs & assigns and against every other person claiming or to

 Gill land all that tract or parcel of Land whereon, lying on both  
 sides of Ogal Camp Creek, "W<sup>th</sup> Middle fork saluda" containing one  
 hundred and sixty nine acres more or less, which Land was Granted to  
 Thomas Edwards Junr. by his Excellency James B. Richardson bearing  
 date the fourth day of June one thousand Eight hundred four and  
 Bounded as followeth, Beginning on a Black Gum running S 75  
 W. 50. c. 11. 81 links to a chestnut, thence N. 15. W. 20 ch. to a Black oak, near  
 a road, thence N. 65. E. 72 ch. to a Pine, thence S. 8. W. 24 ch. 25 links
