



Presents that William Toney of Greenville District in the State
aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred
Dollars to me paid by Hugh Rogers of the same place, have Grant-
ed bargained sold and released, and by these presents do Grant
Bargain sell and release unto the said Hugh Rogers all that
plantation or tract of Land containing one Hundred and seventy
Acres (more or less) situate in Ninety six District on Saluda River
opposite the Confluence of George's Creek bounding said River
and all other sides on Vacant Land when first Surveyed and
Granted to James Clayton, beginning at a white Oak on said
River running N. 26. E. 49. 50 to a Stake corner thence N. 70. W. 42
30 to a white Oak on said River thence down the meanders of said
River to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belon-
ging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Hugh
Rogers his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself
my heirs Exors & admors to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Hugh Rogers, In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this 12th day of February 1814
