 up said creek, the water to be the line, to the beginning, including one hun-  
 dred acres of Land, more or less together with all and singular the premises  
 before mentioned unto the said William Kelly his heirs and assigns forever and  
 we do hereby bind ourselves our heir executor administrators and assigns to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular the one hundred acres of land situate as  
 above mentioned together with the rights and appurtenances there unto belonging  
 unto the said William Kelly his heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs  
 and assigns and against all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or  
 to claim the whole or any part thereof In witness whereof we do hereunto set our  
 hands and seals this fourth day of October in the year of our lord one thou-  
 sand eight hundred and Eleven and in the thirty sixth year of the sovereignty and  
 Independence of the United States of America - Signed sealed & delivered in  
 the presence of this 12 day of October 1811 -

 that I William Kelly of the State and District of aforesaid in consideration of the sum of  
 four Hundred Dollars to me in hand Paid by Samuel Williams of the State & District  
 aforesaid have granted Bargained sold & Released & by these presents do Grant bargain  
 sold & Release unto the said Samuel Williams a plantation and Tract of Land  
 containing two hundred acres including the Plantation wherein Fielding Curtis now  
 lives, Beginning on a Hickory at the mouth of a branch on the bank of Saluda  
 river, thence running N. 60 E 5 to a Stake, thence N 60 E 8 to a Dogwood, then  
 N 51 E 5.50 to a cedar Oak, thence N 38 E 13 to a Stake on Maxwell's line, then
