Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry Pike a certain Plantation or tract of Land containing Ninety five acres lying in the district of Greenville & State aforesaid on a branch of Brushy Creek of Enoree river, whereas it beginning on a Red Oak Corner, thence W. 15, S. 76 W. 10 to red Oak Corner, from thence S. 61 to Pine corner, thence S 50. 45 to maple corner, thence S 52. 40 71 to a Spanish Oak, from thence S. 76 W. 10 to Post oak corner, thence S 57 W. 1. to Post oak corner, thence S. 14 E 14. 20 to Post oak corner, from thence N. 63 E 34 to B. Jack Corner, thence N 11 to post oak corner, from thence N. 15. 50 to the beginning corner, — Also a certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty acres situate in the State aforesaid & district of Greenville on a small branch of Brushy Creek waters of Enoree river bounded on the North by said first described tract of land E. by Wm Taylor Senr. & So by Wm. Ferguson ^{beginning} on a Post oak Corner & runs N. 63 E 34 ch. to O. Jack C. thence S. 31 to Post oak C. — then N. 70 W. 23. 50 to Post oak C. then N. 55 W 9. 50 to beginning post oak corner Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances thereunto Belong or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto sd Henry Pike his heirs and assigns forever. and I do hereby Bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the sd premises unto the sd Henry pike his heirs and assigns. against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully Claiming or to Claim the same or any part thereof — — — Witness my hand and Seal this 10th day of August in the year of our lord 1811 and in the thirty sixth year of the Independence of the United States of America — signed sealed & delivered in presence of
