


³³⁹ Hubby acknowledged HAVE granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John French Twenty five acres of land lying in the district aforesaid near Pearce, Ford on Saluda River, being part of a tract whereon George French lives, and contains all the lands cultivated in five years after the first settlement made by Geo. French in 1791 with all and singular the rights, members & appurtenances to said land belonging incident or ~~or~~ ⁱⁿ any wise appertaining and the right title claim or interest the said George French had in the said land at the time of sale. To have and to hold the said land as above described unto the said John French his heirs and assigns forever (subject as above mentioned) In witness whereof I John Wood Sheriff as aforesaid have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written -

Know all men by these presents, that I Stephen Patton of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by David Thomas of the aforesaid State and District, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do give, grant, release, and make over unto the Said David Thomas, a certain tract of land, situate lying, and being in the aforesaid State and District, on the waters of Saluda River, containing Thirtysix acres more or less, it being part of a tract of land granted to Robert Gillard. (The coarse distance and boundary of the lines of the Said part or tract of land, are as follows (viz) Beginning on a Stake 111^x thence N. 5° 0' W. 15 ch. to a Stake, bounded by land belonging to Isaac west, thence S. 50 W. 35 ch. to a pine 111^x bounded by land belonging to the said "David Thomas," thence S. 75 E. 23 ch. 25 l. "to a Stake 111^x bounded by land belonging to Barksdale D. Garrison, thence N. 33 E. 15 ch. to the beginning 111^x bounded by land belonging to myself) together with all and singular of the Said bargained premises, to the Said David Thomas, his heirs, and lawful representatives, to have and to hold forever. I the Said Stephen Patton no warrant and forever defend the Said bargained premises, against myself, my heirs, and representatives, and against every other
