for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred "dollars" to us in hand paid  
by Loving Rofs of the State and District aforesaid, hath bargained and sold, and by  
these Presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Loving Rofs, All That Tract or parcel  
of Land Containing one hundred and fifty six acres, more or less, lying & being in the  
State and District aforesaid, lying and being on the branches of the beaver dam of Saluda  
river, being part of a tract of land originally granted to Elizabeth Beale, Wife of  
Tavina Beale, and running as follows, beginning on a Post oak & running S 45 W. 30.° to a  
White Oak on W<sup>m</sup> Stones Spring branch, thence down the north side of said branch  
running S 13. E. 12.° to a dogwood & thence running on lands of Charles Ester, Junr. N 89 E. 50.°  
to a Post oak, Dead, thence N. 10 E 28 ch to a white oak, joining lands of Charles Ester,  
Senr. thence N. 80 W. 37.° to the beginning, Together with all and singular the rights,  
members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the s<sup>d</sup> premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said Loving Rofs his heirs and assigns forever. And  
we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the s<sup>d</sup> Loving Rofs his  
Heirs and assigns, and against ourselves, our heirs, and against every other person  
or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Witness  
our hands and seals this eighteenth of February, in the year of our Lord one  
thousand eight hundred and fifteen, and in the thirty ninth of American
