in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty six, the second day of October, also the other Grant signed by his excellency William Moultrie to Edwin Smith for six hundred and eight acres of land adjoining the above mentioned land of Raulston, in the said district & State, all round Raulston, Saluda excepted the fifth day of June one thousand seven hundred and eighty six, and in the tenth year of America's independence, Beginning at the mouth of Coolidge's Spring branch, a straight course East along a line of marked trees to Stake 34 thence N. 60 W. 59.50 to a red oak 34 thence N. 33 to a red oak Station thence a West course along marked trees to the head of a branch, thence a straight course to the mouth of said branch at Saluda river, thence down Saluda to the beginning line of marked trees. Together with all & singular the rights, members and tithes thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining; also all the right title claim or demand of him the said Stephen Butterworth of in and to the same premises unto the said Jacob Cooley his heirs & assigns, I do warrant & for ever defend these premises against myself my heirs executors administrators or assigns, or any other person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. I except two acres of a piece of old field adjoining Ezekiel Vincent. Signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us.
