1<sup>st</sup> Samuel Earle & Harriet his Wife have received, in addition to property heretofore received by them, one negro fellow named Abam, one negro wench named Nance and her young child Travis, one girl named Eliza, one negro Boy named Abam and one girl named Floro, and shall stand charged as having received of the said Estate from the first to the present time the sum of three thousand one hundred & fifty dollars.

2<sup>d</sup> John H. Harrison in addition to the property heretofore received by him shall take one Negro fellow named Pinner, one negro girl named Phebe and an old fellow named Jupiter, and stand charged as having received from the first to the present time the sum of two thousand seven hundred dollars nineteen cents —

3<sup>d</sup> Jane Wright in addition to the property received at her marriage, has received all the ready money on hand at the time of the death of the said James Harrison, one negro fellow named Mark, one negro wench named Jude, and her small child, one girl named Silby, one boy named Bob, one other boy named Harry, and one boy named Allen. and shall stand charged as having received of the said Estate from the first to the present time the sum of two thousand eight hundred and forty dollars, over and above all the ready money above mentioned, which last is a specific legacy, and is hereby acknowledged to be fully paid —

4<sup>th</sup> James Harrison in addition to his old account, has received six Negroes, Edy & his children, Bella, Betsey, Jerry, Johnson and Norman, and also a Cripples boy named Willie, and shall be charged as having received from the first to the present time, the sum of two thousand eight hundred and eighty one dollars & fifty six cents.

5<sup>th</sup> Richard Harrison has in addition to his old account received, one boy named Morris, and one girl named Sidney, and shall be charged with the sum of two thousand seven hundred and eighty two dollars forty eight cents, from the first to the present time.

6<sup>th</sup> Isham Harrison shall have one negro fellow Tobe, and one boy, Simon, in addition, and shall be charged from the first to the present time, the sum of two thousand five hundred and seventy nine dollars. —

7<sup>th</sup> Thomas Harrison in addition to property heretofore received, shall have one wench named Binda and her three children George, Flanders and Dolly, and one old wench named Dolly, and shall be charged as having received the sum of two thousand eight hundred and fifty dollars from the first to the present time. —

8<sup>th</sup> Rowland Thurmond, & Elizabeth his Wife have received five hundred and eighty five dollars in cash, in addition to the property before received by them, and shall be charged with the sum of two thousand eight hundred and thirty five dollars, from first to the present time. —

9<sup>th</sup> And Early Harris and Polly L. his Wife shall receive in addition one Family of Negroes, Isaac, Patience & Cornelia, one Waggon and gear, and one Horse, and shall be charged with the sum of three thousand one hundred and five dollars, from the first to the present time.
