with this indenture to Benjamin Saxon & Daniel H. Sillinghest, have granted
bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell &
release and convey unto the said Benjamin & Daniel all that tract or
parcel of land containing one hundred and sixty acres whereon I Stotter
now live, bounded on the north by Isaac Windly on the south by Thoma,
Fair on the East by John Benson on the West by Charly Pearson land,
together with all and a singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
to have & to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Benj^m
& Daniel their heirs and assigns forever. Provided nevertheless and
upon condition that if the said Jeremiah Stotter his heirs, executors
or administrators shall well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the
said Benjamin & Daniel their certain attorney, executor, administrators or
assigns the full and just sum of Two hundred Dollars on the nineteenth
day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred fifteen
then and in such case and at all times from thenceforth these presents
and said note given as a collateral security and all the Estate hereby
granted, and every article clause and sentence herein contained, shall
cease determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes, any thing
herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding. Signed Sealed and
