Paffity and conveyed through different hands down to the said Hide the land to be  
conveyed Begins on a stake in the big road and runs due S<sup>74</sup> E<sup>17</sup> to a pine 37 S. 65 W. 1.50  
to a P.O. 34 S. 23 E. 19.50 to a stake 34 S. 56 E. 16 chains to a P.O. 34 S. 32 E. 33 chains to a stake  
bounded by Blacks line N 14 E. 15 chains to a maple 37 on branch then down S.  
Branch 13 ch<sup>r</sup> to a stake 37 then N. 16 E. 13.50 to a pine stump on the big road  
then with the said road to the beginning stake bounded by Joseph Kellys line  
including one hundred and ninety two acries be the same more or less Together  
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have

Kelly his heirs and assigns and I do hereby bind myself my heirs & adm<sup>rs</sup>  
to warrant and defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said John Kelly his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs  
and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim

aforesaid including the head of a small branch of Peter's creek of Cooney,  
where Samuel Lewis formerly lived Beginning on a red oak corner on a  
dividing line between James Lewis & Isaac Towers & runs on S. Line S. 30 to a  
Maple corner thence S. 60 E. 6 chains to a poplar corner S. 30 to the N. 10.50 to a
